



WATER-DAY RESTRICTIONS ENDING

All addresses can water any day of the week

Effective immediately, the City of Gustine will no longer be enforcing watering dates specified in the City of Gustine water conservation ordinance approved August 2014. The change comes following Executive Order B-37-16 signed by the Governor on May 9, 2016.

The City Council has begun the process to alter the August 2014 City ordinance. Until that change becomes effective, City personnel will no longer enforce elements of the ordinance related to specific watering days for specific addresses. All addresses can water any days of the week.

At the same time, some restrictions remain in effect in Gustine and the State of California and the following are *prohibited*:

- ***Washing down driveways, sidewalks and hardscapes***
- ***Use of a hose without a shut-off nozzle to wash a motor vehicle***
- ***Use of water in a decorative fountain or water feature **WITHOUT** a recirculation system***
- ***The application of potable water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures; or within 48 hours after measurable precipitation***

While the change in City ordinance will remove watering-day restrictions, the City encourages residents to continue to be conscious of water usage and conserve where practical since the State of California remains in a drought situation.
